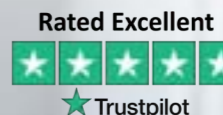

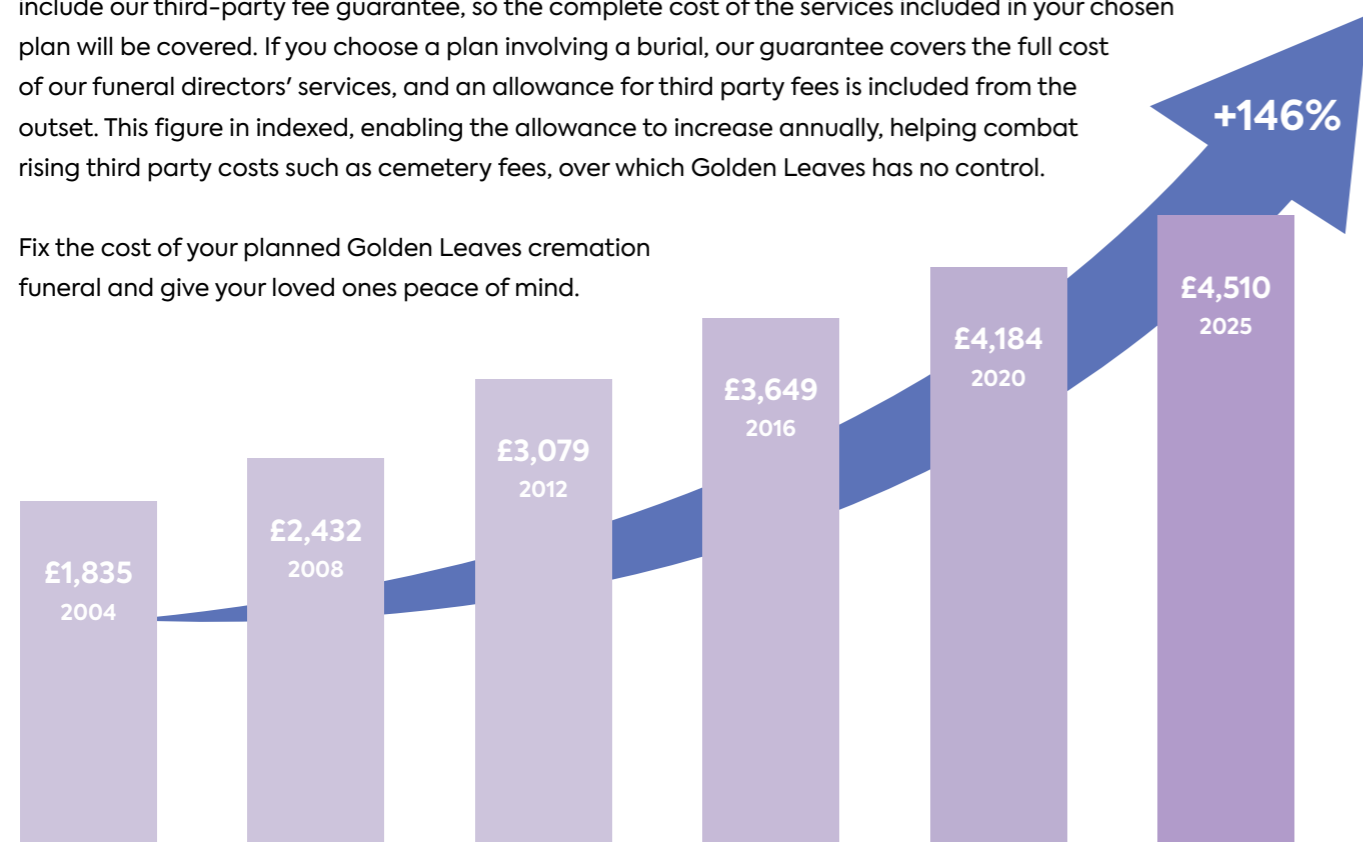

During these two particular years the average price of funerals dropped for the first time due to the pandemic limiting the type and size of funerals permitted by law and the cost of living crisis. Now that the COVID pandemic is over, the cost of funerals is once again rising faster than inflation and is expected to do so for many years to come. Funeral plans can help you avoid those increases in the cost of the funeral.

All Golden Leaves plans protect you completely from any future increases in funeral directors' professional fees and crematorium fees. If you choose a cremation plan, all plans from our range include our third-party fee guarantee, so the complete cost of the services included in your chosen plan will be covered. If you choose a plan involving a burial, our guarantee covers the full cost of our funeral directors' services, and an allowance for third party fees is included from the outset. This figure is indexed, enabling the allowance to increase annually, helping combat rising third party costs such as cemetery fees, over which Golden Leaves has no control.

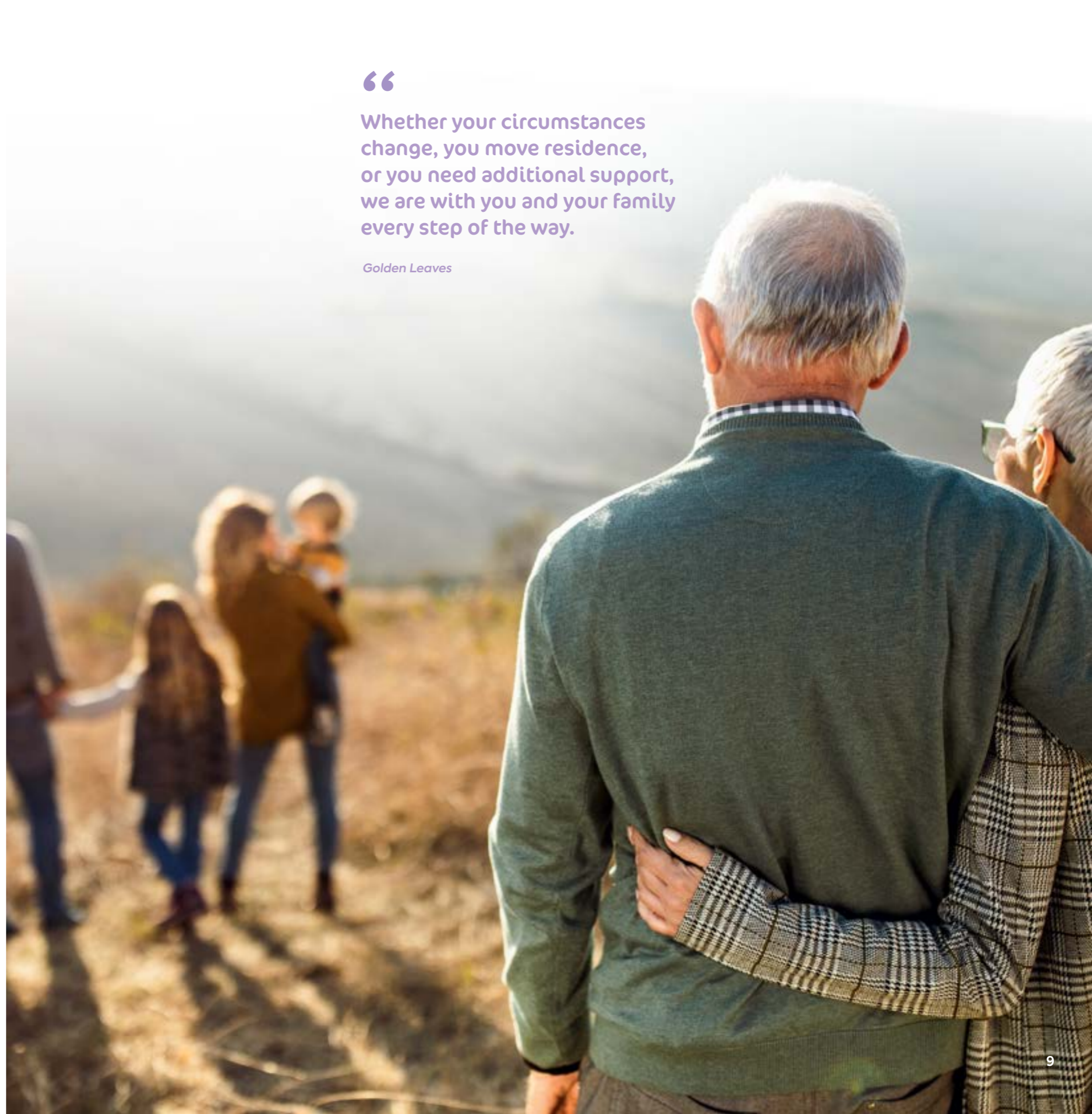

How would you like to be remembered?

We are aware that not everyone wants a traditional styled funeral, or the cost of one. So we have proposed four packaged funeral plan types which should cover most family and individuals funeral choices and a range of budgets. The important thing is that when your time comes, your family will be spared the additional stress of making difficult decisions, and they'll know you cared.

The Copper Plan – from £1,700*

This basic plan provides an unattended direct cremation service only on the UK mainland. This unattended service plan includes the professional services of the funeral director and collection of the deceased from the place of death to the funeral director's premises, 24 hours per day. The subsequent conveyance of the deceased to the crematorium and the cremation fees are also all guaranteed. This plan does not include a funeral service or the provision of cars.

The Copper Plus Plan – from £2,449*

This plan provides a simple family led, attended cremation service for up to 20 people at the crematorium. It includes the professional services of the funeral director (via telephone consultation), and a private vehicle to deliver the wood effect coffin to the crematorium chapel. The time and date of the early morning funeral service is set by the funeral director. This plan is fully guaranteed and includes all professional fees and third-party costs listed in the plan.

The Silver Plan – from £3,725*

This plan provides a cremation or burial service with the professional services of your funeral director, a hearse to meet the mourners at the crematorium or cemetery and a wood effect coffin. It also guarantees the cremation (for a mon-fri service) and ministers fees. If a burial is selected, it includes a contribution towards burial third party fees (so there may be a balance to pay at the time of the funeral).

The Gold Plan – from £4,135*

This plan provides all the elements specified in the Silver plan plus an upgrade to a quality wood effect coffin. It also provides the funeral cortège from the home to the service, with one limousine to transfer the mourners and family to and from the service.

What our plans cover at a glance

Funeral Director Professional Fees:

The professional fees are for the services carried out by funeral directors to conduct either a cremation, or burial funeral. Your allocated funeral directors will assist with all documentation required for a funeral to take place and make the relevant bookings at either the crematorium or cemetery.

They will ensure that when the time comes the planholder is taken into their care and looked after until the day of their funeral. Please take a look at the plan comparison table to the right which shows the services that are included in each of the Golden Leaves funeral plans.

Third Party Fees:

These are costs for essential, non-funeral director services required to carry out a cremation or burial. Funeral directors cannot control these costs and these fees need to be paid at the time of the funeral. These costs are paid by us or by the selected funeral director to other suppliers or professionals to carry out funeral services.

If your plan does not guarantee these costs but includes a contribution only, please note that your estate or next of kin may have to pay the balance if this is more than this amount.

Important information that you should know

Single payment (i.e. in one lump sum): You can cancel within 30 days or within 7 days of us telling you who your funeral director is (if this is later). You'll get all your money back. If you cancel after this, you'll get your money back but we'll keep a £325 charge for administration.

12 months' instalments: You can cancel at any time during the first 12 months and get back everything you've paid. After that, you'll get your money back but we'll keep a £325 charge for administration. Payment option not available if you have been advised by a doctor of a condition or illness that will cause death within 12 months of applying for a plan.

24 months' or longer instalments: You can cancel at any time during the first 12 months and get back everything you've paid. After 12 months, you'll get your money back but we'll keep a £325 charge for administration and we will also retain 50% of the Instalment Payment Fees due up to the date of cancellation. Payment option not available if you have been advised by a doctor of a condition or illness that will cause death within 12 months of applying for a plan.

Commission and payments disclosure

We help many thousands of customers to plan and fund their funerals. Because of economies of scale, we can sell our plans to our customers at a rate which is usually far more cost effective than it would be for them buying from a funeral director at the time of the funeral itself. As a commercial enterprise, we have costs of doing business and promotional marketing. These costs are met by supply side economies of scale delivered by our ability to purchase funerals in bulk and are consequently absorbed into the price of our plans. We retain an amount from the price paid by you for your plan (which is currently £325) to cover the set up of your plan.

We also retain an amount (which currently ranges between £455 and £680 dependent on which plan you purchase) to cover marketing, sales fulfilment expenses and to provide the business with an element of profit. The balance is placed in the Trust in order to pay the appointed funeral director and other costs of the agreed funeral. 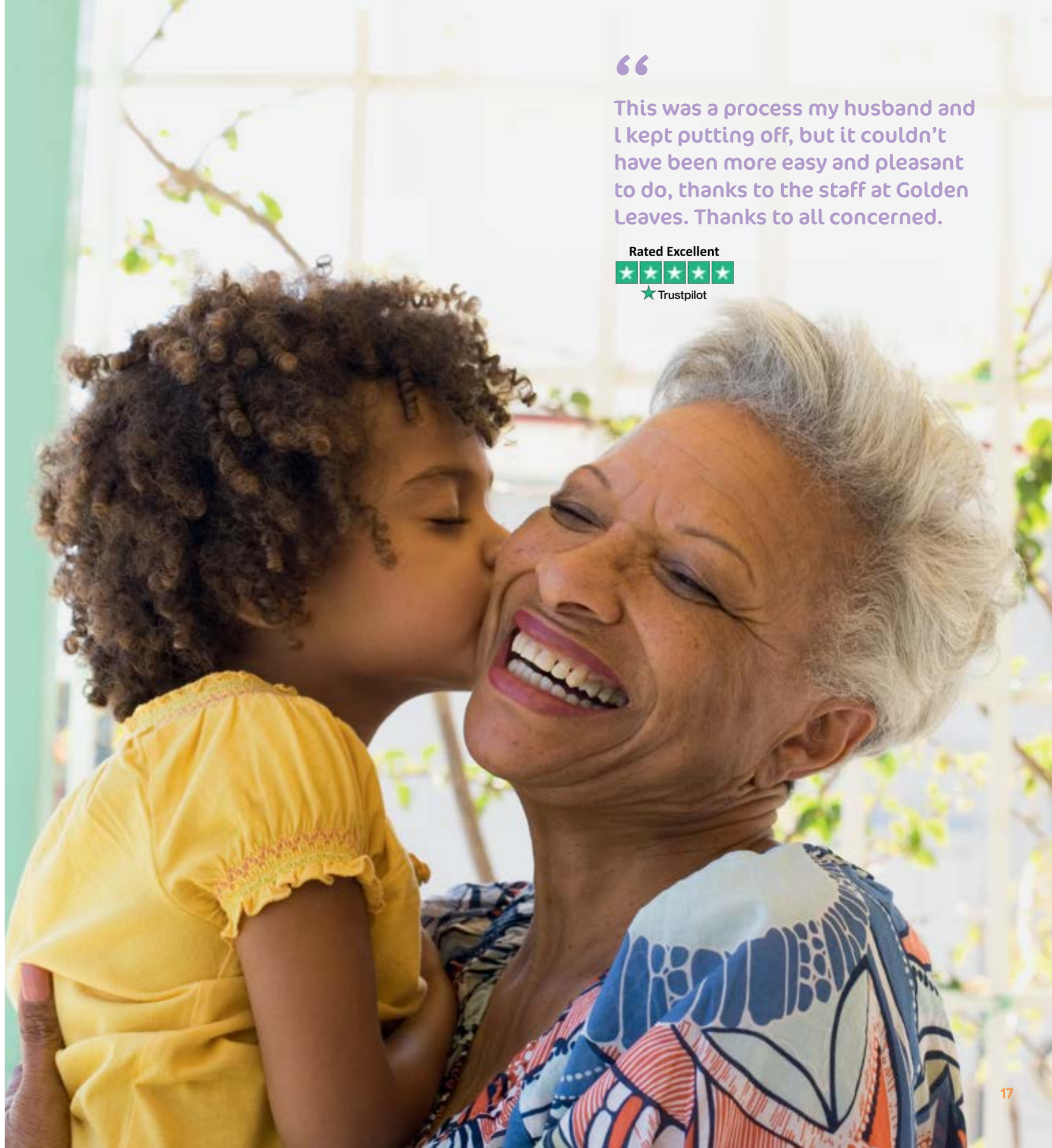

How the process works

How to apply – its easy just a few easy steps

Step One

Visit goldenleaves.com or call us on **0800 85 44 48**.

One of our friendly consultants will assist you or book you a home visit should you prefer.

Step Two

You will complete a demands and needs assessment and discuss your requirements with your consultant. At this point you will select a plan and payment type. (Please be aware that we cannot provide on advice on what you should choose, just provide you with the available options)

Step Three

If there is a plan that suits your requirement, you will be provided with a demands and needs statement, terms and conditions document and a plan summary document, which will include an outline of the cost of the plan you have selected. These documents will all be emailed to you.

Step Four

When the application has been received, Golden Leaves will:

- ✓ Issue you your funeral plan document

Questions?

You can find answers to our most commonly asked questions below, but if you have a query that isn't listed or if you would just like to speak to someone directly, please don't hesitate to get in touch!

Why should I pay now it'll be years before I need a funeral?

We'll all need a funeral one day and with costs expected to rise every year, it makes sense to plan your funeral while you can and fix the cost by paying for it now.

If I decide to purchase my plan over 12 monthly instalments, what happens if I die before I have paid them all?

If death occurs due to natural causes within the repayment period, the plan will be cancelled and the monthly premiums will be refunded back to the estate or to the individual who purchased the plan on the deceased's behalf. If the death was accidental then the plan will still provide the funeral benefits with no further balance to pay.

Can I buy a plan for my spouse?

Yes, you can take out a plan for anyone else. All correspondence will be sent directly to the person arranging the plan and confidentiality is assured, unless you request otherwise.

Can I request a local funeral director to deliver my Golden Leaves funeral service?

Golden Leaves will endeavour to allocate the delivery of your funeral services to a local funeral director of your choice (if required) providing they agree to provide the funeral services to our client on our behalf and meet our stringent service standards. (Except for the Copper plan or Copper Plus plan where Golden Leaves will select the funeral provider without exception).

Is acceptance for an instalment plan purchase guaranteed?

Anyone aged 18 or over may purchase a plan. If you choose an instalment option longer than 12 months, all payments must be completed before your 80th birthday. When purchasing a plan for someone else, instalments must be completed before their 80th birthday. If you have been advised by a doctor that you have a medical condition or illness that will result in death within 12 months of applying, you may still take out a plan; however, only a single payment option will be available.

Who delivers my Golden Leaves funeral?

Golden Leaves will deliver your funeral services via one of our network of approved funeral directors. If the service is delivered by one of our network, we will pay them a contractually agreed fee to deliver the funeral to you, our client.

Once I have fully purchased my plan, are there extra costs?

The services of the funeral director are guaranteed to be covered. Outside of the guaranteed cremation options certain third party fees may require a further payment at the time of the funeral. However, for those plans where an allowance towards third party fees has been included, we will guarantee any increase to these costs in line with the Consumer Price Index (CPI).

What if I die at home and have a direct cremation plan?

The Copper plan will still be activated and collection is now included in the plan 24 hours a day from mainland UK.

How do I know the money will be there when it's needed?

The money you've paid for your funeral is held in an independently managed Golden Leaves Trust. Independent fund managers are tasked to manage the long-term growth of the fund, specifically to meet the increasing cost of funeral services.

What happens to the money I pay for my plan?

The company retains an amount from the price paid by you for your plan (currently £325) to cover the administrative costs of running the business for the life of your plan. In addition, if you pay in instalments over 24 months or longer, an annual 6% instalment payment fee is charged. The balance is placed in the Trust in order to pay our funeral suppliers (for further information if required, please visit goldenleaves.com and refer to our price breakdown summary table, contained in our Commissions and Payment Disclosure).

If I decide to purchase my plan over 24 months or longer instalments, what happens if I die before I have paid them all?

If death occurs from natural causes in the qualifying period (the first 12 months), the plan will be cancelled and all payments refunded to the estate or to the individual who purchased the plan, but no funeral will be provided. If death in the qualifying period was accidental then a funeral will be provided, with no balance to pay. If you die after the qualifying period, the funeral will be provided with no further payments due.

What is the Crematorium Fee Guarantee?

The Golden Leaves plans guarantee the crematorium fees for a single slot Mon-Fri cremation. Weekends or extended services would require additional payments

If I purchase a Copper plan, can I have a service for my family to attend?

The Copper plan is a direct cremation service and therefore unfortunately doesn't include a service for mourners. Many people do hold a separate memorial service at a later date, once they have collected the cremated remains of their loved one.

If I purchase a Copper Plus plan can I choose the crematorium?

The Copper Plus plan is currently available for the funeral service to be carried out at a national network of crematoriums. At the time of plan purchase you will be able to select a crematorium from this network.

Can I upgrade/downgrade my plan to another if I change my mind?

Yes, you can change your plan but we may charge a small fee for administration. You can then take out a new plan from the currently available plans.

Can I cancel my plan?

Yes, of course. But your rights depend on how you pay for your plan. You have a right to cancel any plan (however you pay for it) within 30 days or within 7 days of being told who your allocated funeral director is, if this is later than 30 days. If you do this, you'll get all your money back.

If you pay for your plan by instalments over 12 months or longer, you have extended cancellation rights. You can cancel at any time within 12 months of taking out your plan and get all your money back. If you cancel after 12 months, you can still get your money back but we'll keep a £325 charge for administration. If your instalment period is 24 months or longer then in addition to our administration charge, we will also retain 50% of the Instalment Payment Fees due up to the date of cancellation.

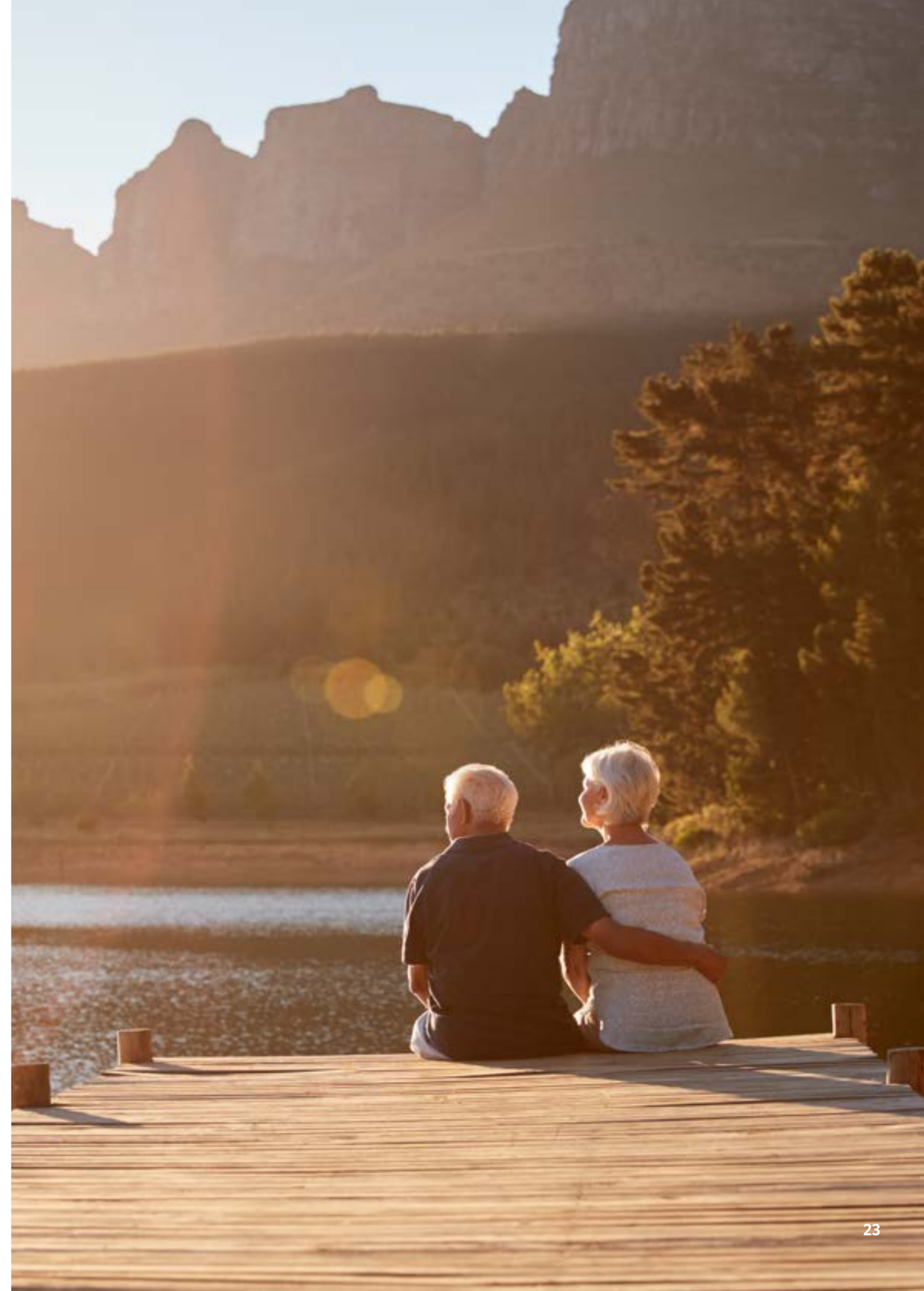

The Golden Leaves Trust is also authorised from time to time to make such further surplus distribution payments to the company in line with the FCA's rule FPCOB 3.2.12R, subject to professional actuarial advice and the approval of the Golden Leaves Board of Trustees.
